

Terms and Conditions: Mercure Hotels Picnic at Somerset House.

1. AGREEMENT TO OFFICIAL RULES:

Reservations attempted through the use of agencies or robotic, repetitive, automatic, programmed, or similar methods will be void. The Promoter does not accept responsibility for network, computer, hardware or software failures of any kind, which may restrict or delay the sending or receipt of your booking. Reservations that are incomplete, illegible or contain false information will be rejected.

The Promoter has the absolute discretion to refuse any reservation and entry to the Event.

3. CONDITIONS OF THE EVENT:

The Promoter reserves the right to change, cancel or postpone the Event or any part of it at any time. In the event of such cancellation, the Promoter will attempt to contact all participants who have reserved a ticket in order to inform them of the cancellation.

The Promoter reserves the right to make changes to the Event at any time. The Promoter has the discretion to refuse entry of any group or individual to the Event. Participants at the Event (or a child under the supervision of a participant) will be liable for any damage that they or their children do to the Venue or to the equipment at the Venue the Promoter reserves the right to charge for such damage.

Participants accept that the Promoter will have the right, without additional payment or permission, to take pictures and video footage throughout the event at Somerset House and use this for promotional purposes.
